

### Summary of the Anglers' Code of Conduct.

1. All Anglers aged 12 years or over must be in possession of an Environment Agency National Rod Licence, purchasable from any main Post Office.
2. Anglers may only fish from angling stations where they are provided or from areas otherwise designated.
3. Except by prior consent, fishing at night (between the hours of dusk and dawn) on all park lakes is prohibited.
4. The movement of fish stocks from water body to water body is prohibited
5. Except by prior consent anglers are restricted to the use of 1 x Rod or 1 x Pole per person.
6. All litter and fishing line to be removed from the immediate vicinity after each fishing session.
7. Except by prior consent, tents and bivouacs are prohibited within the park and lake area.
8. Vehicles are prohibited from the park and lake area.
9. General Good Behaviour
10. Good Manners and Good Citizenship

## Our Pledge to Anglers

- We (the City Council) will continue to work hard with our partners, the Environment Agency (and others) to maintain water quality and fish stocks at appropriate levels for each site.
- We will keep the parks clean and safe and respect all legitimate users.
- We will seek to invest in lake infrastructures and facilities.
- We will inspect each lake at least once per week.
- We will direct our service provider to maintain park lakes on a weekly basis, and whenever required.
- We will continue to notify of any works scheduled for lakes that may affect anglers or other lake users.
- We will make best use of existing council bye laws to ensure the safety, well being and comfort of all users.
- We will assist in developing "Liverpool Direct" to receive and process reports and comments.

## Terms of Registration

1. From 1st October 2007, all casual Anglers who use the facilities at Liverpool Park Lake sites will be required to be registered with the City Council.
2. Only by Registering, can anglers gain the "authority" and "permission" to fish Liverpool's Lakes.
3. Following Registration, the applicant will receive (by mail) a Registration Card that will contain a unique Registration Number
4. Anglers that are not registered by this date and are found to be fishing Liverpool's Lakes will be deemed to be fishing without permission and therefore may be removed from the Ground and/or subject to appropriate penalties on the basis of their non compliance with the bye laws and/or obstruction of officers of the Council
5. Registration is FREE and should initially be renewed by 1<sup>st</sup> April 2009 and annually thereafter.
6. Registrants will be required to show their Anglers registration Card upon demand by any Officer of the Council. If, upon request an Angler fails to show his card he/she will be deemed to be fishing without permission and therefore may be removed from the Ground and/or subject to appropriate penalties on the basis of their non compliance with the bye laws and/or obstruction of officers of the Council.
7. Any Registered Angler who is deemed to have contravened the Terms of Registration, including breaches of the Code of Conduct or/and bye laws will be deemed to be fishing without permission and therefore may be removed from the Ground and/or subject to appropriate penalties on the basis of their non compliance with the bye laws and/or obstruction of officers of the Council.  
Further, Registration will be cancelled without appeal until the next Registration deadline when a fresh application can be made.

8. Only Registered persons may fish or take part in any pre arranged Fishing event that is resourced, sponsored or endorsed through the Council or its Agents, including Friends Groups or Partners.

9. The Council reserves the right to amend or withdraw all or part of "authorities" or "permissions" without notice, if in the judgement of the Council Public Health and Safety may be compromised or when lake improvements or emergency works may take priority.

10. All Registrants will be required to hold a National Rod Licence issued by the Environment Agency.

Once you have read the Terms of Registration and the Anglers Code of Conduct and indicated that you have understood and agreed with all terms, you must then take the completed Form together with 2 forms of identity to either;

- Your local One Stop Shop
- Walton Hall Park Leisure Centre

Upon receipt of this completed form we will Post out to you at your registration address a "Registration Card" indicating that Permission to Fish Park Lakes has been granted, together with a unique registration number which will be allocated to you alone.

Acceptable forms of identity will include;

- Rent Book
- Current Drivers Licence
- Current Passport
- Fishing Licence
- Birth Certificate
- Current Utilities Bill
