14. APPLICATION FOR A LAWFUL DEVELOPMENT CERTIFICATE FOR AN EXISTING USE OR OPERATION OR ACTIVITY INCLUDING THOSE IN BREACH OF PLANNING CONDITION

NATIONAL REQUIREMENTS (three copies unless submitted electronically)

- Completed form
- The appropriate fee
- Location plan with application site edged red and any adjoining land owned by the applicant edged blue at scale of 1:1250 with north point.
- Such evidence verifying the information included in the application as can be provided (Statutory Declaration from person/persons with knowledge of the existing use/works carried out).
- Such other information as is considered to be relevant to the application (bills, receipts, rent books).
- Reasons, if any, for regarding the use, operations or other matter described in the application as lawful.

LOCAL REQUIREMENTS

- Floor plans at 1:50 where certificate for lawful use of building sought. YES N/A
- Floor plans and elevations at 1:50/1:100 where certificate for lawful operations sought. YES N/A
- Site plan at 1:200 where certificate for lawful use of land sought. YES N/A
- In the case of an application for a certificate of lawfulness for an existing use the date on which the use, operations or other matter began or, in the case of operations carried out without planning permission, the date on which the operations were substantially completed. YES N/A
