## **Equipment Information Helpline**

Disabled Living Centre staff have access to a huge range of information on equipment – just telephone, write in or e-mail with your enquiry.

An Occupational Therapist will discuss your needs with you and we will send you useful information.

## **Permanent Display of Equipment**

With over 2,000 products on display the centre has the largest range of equipment in the area. This gives you the opportunity to see and try equipment with the help of expert advisors.

## **Visits to the Centre and Open Days**

Open Days allow visitors access to the whole display area. Other services join in on Open Days so you can get information on an even wider range of subjects. People from all areas are welcome to Open Days which are held every few weeks.

## **Appointments**

If you live in Liverpool you can book a one-to-one appointment with one of our Occupational Therapists.

We will discuss your needs with you, demonstrate equipment and let you try it so you can be sure it's right for you. Then we'll write up a report with all the information on your visit and send you a copy.

## **How to get equipment**

We will let you know whether the equipment you need can be provided free. The centre does not sell equipment but we have information on national, local and mail-order retailers.

If you have to purchase it yourself, we'll let you know how to find if there are any sources of funding to help. We have a store of smaller items that we can provide free to visitors from Liverpool who need them.
