Liverpool City Centre to Walton

This cycle route is part of Regional Route 81, which runs from Liverpool City Centre through Everton and Walton. It then continues through Sefton along the coast to Southport, and further north to Preston. The Route forms part of the UK's National Cycle Network.

The Route links residents with some of Liverpool's major sites including Anfield and Goodison Football Stadiums. The Route also takes you through two of Liverpool's city parks – Everton, and Stanley Parks. Everton Park offers fantastic views across the River Mersey to the Welsh hills and over Liverpool city centre. Stanley Park is one of Liverpool's most important historic parks, and includes the Isla Gladstone Conservatory. The Liverpool section of the route is about 4 miles long, taking around 30 minutes to cycle.

Sustrans

The National Cycle Network is a network of safe and attractive routes to cycle throughout the UK. This network has rapidly grown in recent years and is delivered through policies and programmes co-ordinated by Sustrans.
