Your questions answered

Q. Will my collections be affected by Bank Holidays?

- A. YES.** If your collection falls on a Bank Holiday Monday, the service will simply rollover by one day ensuring that you still receive a collection in your designated week. For example, Monday's scheduled collections will be on Tuesday, Tuesday's on Wednesday etc. Friday's scheduled collections for that week will therefore be on Saturday. Your calendar dates take these Bank Holidays into account.

The only exceptions to this rule will be Christmas, New Year and Easter when separate guidance regarding recycling collections will be provided by the Council.

Q. What do I do with the Purple Box now that I am using the Blue Bin?

- A.** The boxes will be left with residents as a collection or storage aid within properties. Please note that you cannot put your box out with your Blue Wheeled Bin as it will not be collected.

Q. I am on an assisted collection for my Purple Bin, what will happen about my Blue Wheeled Bin?

- A.** Those residents on the Assisted List for Purple or Green Wheeled Bin collections will automatically be placed on the Assist List for Blue Wheeled Bin collections.

You will soon be receiving a **BLUE WHEELED BIN** for your recycling collections. This will replace the purple box and bag you currently use.

You will also be able to recycle plastics and cardboard in your new Blue Wheeled Bin, and the more you recycle, the more you are helping Liverpool to achieve our targets on landfill and recycling. You will be making a valuable contribution to the local, national and global environment and all your recycling waste will be made into new products, thereby saving natural resources.

We hope you will enjoy using your new Blue Wheeled Bin and would like to thank you for your continued efforts to recycle as much as you can.



What can you put into your new Blue Wheeled Bin?

Yes Please

Please **DO NOT** bag the items before putting them in your Blue Wheeled Bin.



Steel cans, aluminium cans, loose steel lids from bottles and jars
Please rinse but do not crush



Cardboard boxes, food packaging, egg cartons, loo/kitchen rolls, greeting cards
Please flatten



All types and colours except Pyrex and window glass
Please remove lids from jars and bottles, and rinse



Newspapers, magazines, junk mail, office paper, windowless envelopes, paper bags, wrapping paper (please remove sellotape), catalogues, telephone directories and yellow pages



Drinks bottles such as juice, water, milk and cordials. Shampoo bottles, and household cleaner bottles such as fabric softener, washing liquid, etc.
Please empty and rinse, do not flatten

What to do with your new Blue Wheeled Bin?

As soon as you receive your bin you can start to fill it ready for your next collection. Full details of your collection dates will be provided on a calendar that will be delivered with your new bin.

Collections will be every two weeks. On collection day, you should ensure that your bin is presented at the kerbside or your usual collection point, with the lid closed. Please do not leave your bin in a position that could cause an accident on the footway.

Your bin should be presented before 7.30 am on the day of collection, and you should return your bin to your property as soon as possible after it has been emptied.
